

DON'T FLUSH THIS TOILET YET



The average human produces 32 to 64 ounces of urine per day, 95% of which is already water. Your toilet flushes a minimum of 1.6 gallons every time you push the handle down. Say you pee four or five times a day, and flush a toilet every time you do it. You're using a gallon and a half of water to wash a pint of pee into the sewer system. Is that really necessary?

Every day, you're dumping more than 6 gallons of clean water into the toilet just to get rid of some pee – while the world is well on its way to a water crisis, pumping out groundwater far faster than it can be replaced. Think about it. Maybe you can wait until there's something in your toilet worth flushing.
